DESCRIPTION:

FBP23 ES is an emulsifiable biopesticide treatment for control of darkling beetles (lesser mealworm) in livestock and poultry production houses. It is formulated with Beauveria bassiana Strain HF23. This potent formulation provides excellent control of hard to kill darkling beetles including those resistant to other pesticides, including certain pyrethroids.

EFFECTIVENESS:

FBP23 ES controls darkling beetles between flocks and in areas where they accumulate.

PACKAGING:

FBP23 ES is available in a 15 fluid ounce bottle or a case of 12 bottles.

PRODUCT ADVANTAGES:

- 1. FBP23 ES is approved to apply as a spray to walls, floors and posts, where the greatest number of pests are located.
- 2. FBP23 ES is a contact infection material.
- 3. Formulated for application with conventional equipment of user's choice.
- 4. Formulation is approved for organic production.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For use in controlling Darkling Beetle in livestock/poultry production houses.

Use Restrictions

- · Do not use a fungicide prior to application of this product.
- · Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

Application Instructions

Each bottle contains approximately 15 fl. oz. of FBP23™ ES, which treats 30,000 to 50,000 square feet of floor area. Apply FBP23™ ES at a rate of 1.5 to 2 fl. oz. per 5,000 square feet of floor area. Although FBP23™ ES can be applied with conventional equipment of the user's choice, there must not be any filter or screen smaller than 50 microns, which would prevent the active ingredient from passing. Be sure to agitate the contents of the bottle by shaking vigorously to resuspend any sediment that formed in the bottom. Add the contents of the bottle to sufficient water in a mix tank to ensure even coverage over the treated area. Add a small amount of water to the emptied bottle, replace the cap, and shake the bottle again. Add this "rinse" water to the mix tank.

Apply the spray to walls, floors, posts, where the greatest numbers of pests are located. This is a contact infection material. Re-treat between flocks or in areas where darkling beetles accumulate. There is no restriction on the total maximum amount of FBP23™ ES that may be applied in a year. The product is only to be applied to poultry or livestock manure that is to be composted.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is potentially pathogenic to honey bees. Avoid applying to areas where honey bees are actively foraging or around hives. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below mean water mark. Do not contaminate surface water by disposal of equipment wash waters.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place in original container and out of direct sunlight. Do not store at temperatures exceeding 80° F (27° C)

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: To avoid
