## For Use Prior To Disinfection

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Contact your Preserve International representative for questions regarding appropriate dilution for your needs.

Thoroughly saturate all surfaces with BARNSTORM at a dilution rate of 1:64 (2oz per gallon water). Product may be applied through high or low pressure spray apparatus, or immersion. Allow BARNSTORM to remain on surfaces for 10 - 15 minutes.

## FIRST AID

**INTERNAL:** If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Immediately drink a large quantity of water and call a physician. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**EYES:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of clean running water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician.

**EXTERNAL:** In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of clean running water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and shoes. If burn or irritation has occurred, call a physician.

## STEPS TO BE TAKEN

### IN CASE OF A SPILL:

LEAKS SHOULD BE STOPPED. SPILLS SHOULD BE CONTAINED AND CLEANED UP IMMEDIATELY. FOR LIQUID SPILLS, ABSORB SPILL WITH ABSORBENT MATERIAL AND PLACE INTO A SUITABLE CONTAINER OR PICK UP MATERIAL WITH A VACUUM TRUCK. MOP AND THEN FLUSH SPILL AREA WITH WATER TO REMOVE ANY RESIDUE. NOTIFY LOCAL, STATE AND FEDERAL OFFICIALS AS REQUIRED. FOR POWDER SPILLS, SCOOP AND SWEEP UP AREA ON A DRY BASIS, OR MOP AND THEN FLUSH WITH PLENTY OF WATER.
